



PPYH Fire Evacuation Plan – Haven Users

The Royal Southern Yacht Club (RSrNYC) maintains a structured response for emergencies in the Prince Philip Yacht Haven as part of its **Marine Safety Management System (MSMS)**. While specific documents are typically held in the **Sailing Office**, the following procedures apply to fire incidents within the Haven.

Immediate Actions (Fire Emergency)

- **Alert the Club:** Immediately notify the **Duty Bosun (07900 872461)** or the **Clubhouse Reception (02380 450300)**.
- **Emergency Services:** Call **999** and ask for the Fire Service. Clearly state the location as **Prince Philip Yacht Haven, Royal Southern Yacht Club, Hamble-le-Rice**.
- **Safety Equipment:** Familiarize yourself with the **pontoon safety boxes** located throughout the Haven (see plan below), which contain **fire extinguishers, life-rings, MOB Ladders, torches etc.**
- **Evacuation:**
 - Move to the designated **Assembly Point** (located at the top of the car park by the back gate).
 - If the shore route is blocked, move to the nearest **Water Evacuation Point** (see plan below) for extraction by club launch or safety boat.
